Judging system

The ISU Judging System will be used. Teams that have participated in a particular category in the current season are not allowed to take part in a different category at the SwisscupWidnau 2024.

Official Training

Official Training takes place on Saturday morning, 2 March 2024 or Sunday morning, 3 March 2024. Official training is compulsory for all teams.

The cost of travel, accommodation and catering is the responsibility of skaters and their respective clubs.

Bookings for accommodation and/or catering should be made as soon as possible or at the latest by

31 January 2024, using:

Bookings must be paid for before the competition. The team manager will receive an invoice by mail two weeks before competition. Payments must be made before the competition date. Bank details are on the invoice. In case of cancellations these payments are non-refundable. If the competition cannot be held due to extraordinary events, 25% of the accommodation and food payments will be retained to cover the cost price. The participating club will be refunded 75% of the paid accommodation and food costs.

Draw

The draw will be done by the Organizer prior to the event and communicated with the final Schedule.

Foreign judges

In accordance with ISU Rules, each participating ISU Member entering a team may propose its own judge to the organizer. Judges shall be National judges for Synchronized Skating or judges listed on the ISU List of Referees and Judges for Sychronized Skating. Judges should be registered using the official registration form as early as possible, but no later than **30 November 2023.**

Expenses for Judges and Technical Panel members

The compensation of the officials will be paid in principle according to the guidelines of the "Compensation rates for competitions, tests and courses in synchronised skating" valid in Switzerland. For technical specialists, technical controllers and referees, the costs will be covered from Friday evening, 01.03.2024 until Sunday evening, 03.03.2024, if arrival is not possible on the day of the competition. All other expenses shall be the responsibility of each official or their sponsoring association or club.

Judges meeting

The first Judges Meeting will take place two hours before competition start on Saturday, 2 March 2024, on the first floor of the Sport Centre. A Round Table Discussion can take place on Sunday, 3 March 2024, in arrangement with the event referee.

Provisional schedule

The final schedule and allocation of categories for Saturday and Sunday can only be organized following the receipt of registrations. The integrated Swiss Championships are scheduled as follows:

Saturday/Practice & Competition Short Program Junior ISU & Senior ISU

Sunday/Practice & Competition Free Skating Advanced Novice, Junior ISU and Senior ISU AND Juvenile.

The teams competing in NON-ISU categories are requested to reserve both days, as a start on either Saturday or Sunday cannot be guaranteed in advance.
